Exploring Chemistry in Human Health Summer Academy Student Mentor Application

The Summer Academy is for twenty 8^{th-}, 9^{th-}, and 10^{th-}grade students with 5 college-aged mentors and UCO staff in each session. Each session is one week: June 10-14 and June 17-21. The emphasis is to apply chemistry and scientific methods to emerging technologies and to learn about the relevance of chemistry in our lives, in human health, and in nutrition.

Student mentors are expected to serve as role models and to assist the students during the workshop. Student mentors will also assist faculty in setting up equipment and supplies, guiding attendees with experiments, and with other duties as assigned.

The salary is \$10/hour (although FICA is taken out) and the hours will be 8:00am to 5:00pm, M-F. There may be some additional hours for preparation beforehand and again after the academy is completed to clean glassware and stow supplies.
