Exploring Chemistry in Human Health Summer Academy Student Mentor Application

The UCO Summer Academy hosts twenty 8^{th-}, 9^{th-}, and 10^{th-}grade students with five college-aged mentors and UCO staff in each session. Each session is one week: June 1-5 and June 8-12. We emphasize the application of chemistry and scientific methods to emerging technologies and learn about the relevance of chemistry in our lives, in human health, and in nutrition.

Student mentors are expected to serve as role models and to assist the students during the activities. Student mentors will also help faculty with equipment and supplies, oversee some experiments, and support the academy by performing other duties as assigned.

The salary is \$10/hour (although FICA is taken out) and the hours are 8:00am to 5:00pm, M-F. There may be some additional hours for preparation the weeks before the academy and again after the academy is completed to clean glassware and stow supplies.

Notes:

1. You cannot be enrolled in Block I summer school with daytime classes and participate as a student mentor.

2. If hired, the university is required to conduct a background check on you.
